This e-course aims to perfect and consolidate the skills of handling child protection cases mainly for social workers working in different social service centres in Lebanon. The e-course is developed on the basis of the recently established National Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for the protection of children in Lebanon. Introduction This E-course is an eight-module course that introduces social workers and case managers working with children on concepts and procedures of case management for child protection. It helps them to better address the problems faced by children at risk and/or victims of violence, exploitation and abuse, and to refine and strengthen the skills of child protection case management primarily among social workers working in various social service centres throughout Lebanon. It does not replace or reproduce the curriculum for social workers, but refers to them. All links provided within the course are for informational purposes only. Participants will not be certified professionals after attending the course or after receiving the certificate of completion.
