How to get rid of your password on your phone

However, in most cases we want to remove the password we have just forgotten. My answer is based on this. For Android 4.4 and below, you can access Google Account to restore the password. For Android 5.0 and later, you can set a TMP password for the phone via Android Device Manager Service. And use the TMP password to unlock the phone.
