In 1816 Coleridge sought treatment for his diegance dependence with Highgate Surgeon James Gillman. He moved to Gillman's house and there remained his death on July 25, 1834. This was a happier period in the life of Coleridge and he became known as the 'highgate' sibio. He rebukes William Wordsworth, for what browning considered his desertion of the liberal cause, and his lapse of his high idealism.
